- Writing

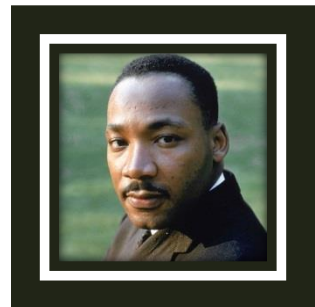
## **WHAT TO SUBMIT**
